Off To The Races

San Francisco trial lawyer Edward Hugo will be taking his wheels later this month to Mexico's world-renowned race car competition, La Carrera Panamericana, for his first time. There, he'll race in a 1954 LT Special, which blends the looks of a Cobra and a Ferrari, alongside 100-some other competitors who will traverse almost 2,000 miles from southern Mexico to the Texas border during the six-day event. All the competing cars are vintage, dating back to at least 1955, but they often reach speeds surpassing 150 miles per hour. First conducted between 1950 and 1954, La Carrera Panamericana was revived in 1988. Hugo is shown here in his 2004 Porsche GT3 race car at the Infineon Raceway in Sonoma.
